

# Are You Eligible to Apply for a Houston Alumnae Panhellenic Foundation Scholarship?

# To Qualify, Applicants Must Be:

1. Graduate of a high school located in Harris County, or a high school in one of these contiguous counties: Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Liberty, Montgomery, and Waller (high school transcript required).

**AND**, **both** at the time of application and during the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded:

- **2.** Collegiate member in good standing of a National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) sorority.
- **3.** Full-time, undergraduate student in accordance with the applicant's university at any accredited U.S. college or university (college transcript required).

### **Criteria Considered:**

Listed in order of importance:

- 1. Financial need
- 2. Academic achievement
- **3.** Participation in sorority activities
- **4.** Participation in extracurricular activities (on and off campus)
